Workshop 1: How to publish?

A string of impressive publications can propel a young scientist to the next academic stage, whereas an insufficient publication record can derail a career. Publications are the main way scientists publicize their work, and ultimately, it is by their papers that they will be judged. During this workshop the authors, reviewers, and journal editors of the scientific magazines will give you tips and examples.

- Help ensure that the review process goes smoothly
- Respond to reviewers' comments positively and constructively
- How to deal with rejection

Workshop 2: How to present?

Present your paper means communicate it with others. And the way we communicate dictates a great deal of how successful we are. If you do not have ability to convince others means you will not be heard or seen in many situations. The goal of this workshop is to stimulate your thinking on what it takes for you to be a good communicator when making a scientific presentation.

- Getting through to the audience – presentation style
- Visual and aural aids – proper use of presentation materials and the microphone
- Question time

Workshop 3: How to apply?

The first step in getting any job, placement or internship is to introduce yourself to the employer by sending them a CV or application form. This is the most important stage of the whole application process and it is not an easy one. Summing up your life's experiences on one page can seem an impossible task. In this workshop we help you through the process by offering advice on how to present yourself effectively and more:
